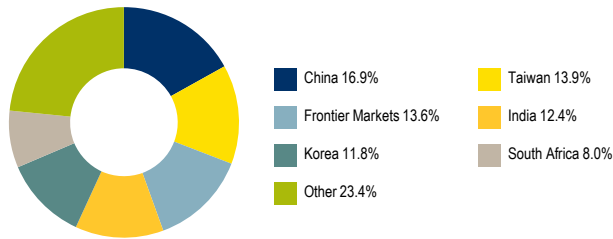

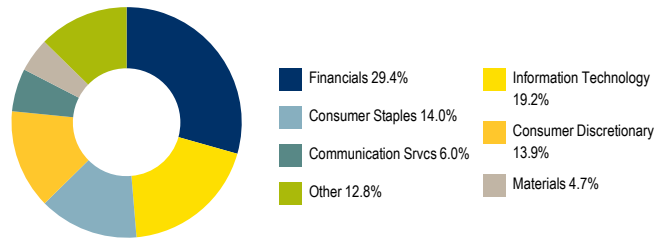

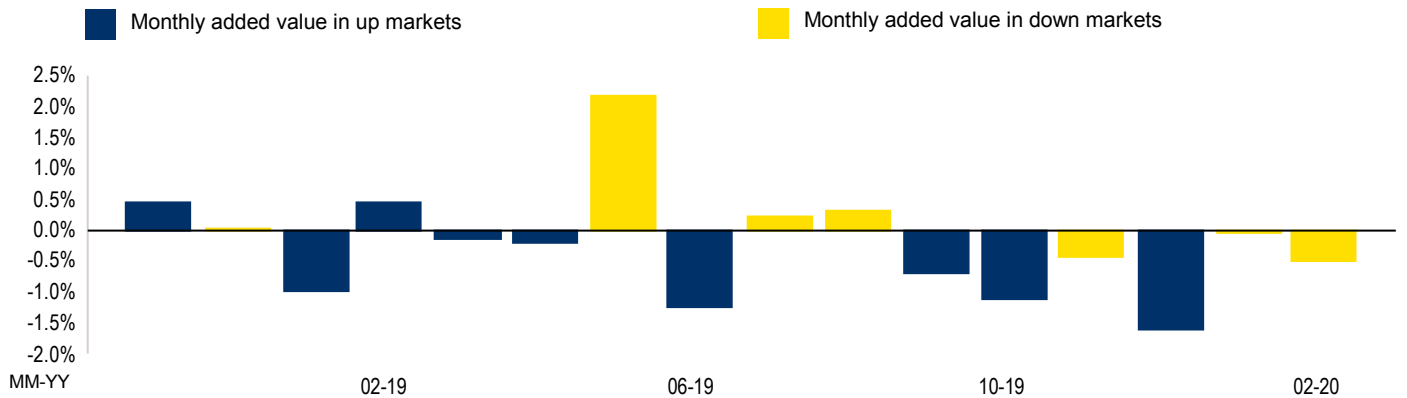

Important Risk Considerations:

Currency Risk:	Sub-Funds are invested in securities denominated in different currencies other than the Reference currency.
